

What is UTAG?

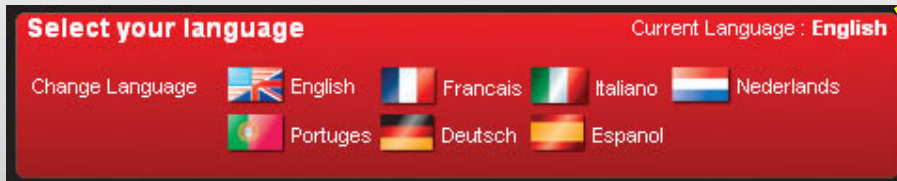
UTAG is a digital dogtag and ICE card that electronically stores vital personal information on a USB device for use in an emergency.

UTAG is available in two fantastic formats, digital dogtag and ICE card, each clearly displaying the international medical symbol (the snake and staff) and the letters ICE which denotes In Case of Emergency.

Digital dogtag can be worn as a traditional dogtag, or on a zip pull or keyring. Each dogtag is supplied with a safety neckchain and additional blank dogtag to personalise. ICE card can be carried in a wallet or purse.

In an emergency, the user or first-aider just needs to connect the UTAG to the USB port of any PC or laptop to access the user's information.

Multiple Language Function




Multiple Language Function this unique feature enables the user's details to be viewed in the 7 most popular European languages used worldwide.

Private Folder

If you are constantly on the move, it is a good idea to carry copies of vital documents such as passport, driving licence, travel documents, health insurance membership etc with you. The Private Folder gives you the opportunity to save copies of these documents (and any other documents/files you require) into a folder on your UTAG. In the private folder you can encrypt your documents so that they can only be accessed by you. This gives you the peace of mind that you have copies of everything you need with you in a secure form that only you can access. Once the document is open it can be displayed or printed. If you no longer require it, it can simply be deleted.

Why UTAG?

UTAG has been specially designed to speak for you when you can't speak for yourself. In the event of an accident the effective application of treatment is essential, UTAG allows the emergency services to give treatment in the safe knowledge that they will not make the situation worse.

Standard information available to the emergency services is blood group, allergies and any current medication that could affect treatment.

The information screen allows the emergency services immediate access to:

- Personal details (name with photo ID)
- GP's name and contact details
- Medical Insurance details
- Next of kin and employers details
- Medical Information;
- Medical conditions
- Current medication
- Allergies
- Blood type
